Parking for The Shuttle

- Paid parking is marked on the route map.

Helpful Hints:

- All Shuttles have bike racks. Space is limited.
- Shuttles have wheelchair lifts for people with disabilities.
- Service is available on request to Outer Cape Health Service, Maushop Senior Housing, and Provincetown Airport. Please call (800) 352-7155.
- Service animals are always accommodated, and pets are welcome on the Shuttle only if leashed or caged and well-behaved. Pets cannot transfer to Flex or other bus services.
- Go to capecodrta.org to view real-time shuttle locations and estimated arrival times.

FLEX

- For hourly service to Stop & Shop
- The Shuttle connects with the FLEX bus route in North Truro at the intersection of Highland Road and Route 6 overpass and at MacMillan Pier.
- The FLEX bus travels between Provincetown and Harwich.
- Between North Truro and Harwich this bus will "flex" off its usual route to locations within 3/4 of a mile to serve people who have difficulty getting to a regular stop. Reservations are required two hours prior to pickup.
